### **Rule 2.123(2)(c)(11)**

#### **First Show Cause Order on Selling or Providing Alcohol to Underage Person**

If an employee of a license holder is for the first time issued by the Board a Show Cause Order for selling or providing alcoholic beverages to individual under twenty-one (21) years of age, such employee may sign a letter in lieu, stating that he/she: 1) will forego attending the Board hearing; and 2) agrees to pay \$100 fine. Signing the letter in lieu does not mean the admission of guilt by an employee. Both signed letter in lieu and proof of payment of \$100 shall be submitted to the Clerk of the Board before the close of business of the day before the scheduled hearing date on the same Show Cause Order, otherwise, the hearing on Show Cause Order will go forward as scheduled. The Clerk to the Board shall maintain a list of first-time offenders. This rule is not applicable to licensees.

### **Rule 2.107.22**

#### **Interest in More Than One License - Prohibited**

Except as otherwise provided by law, a person (individual, entity, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, or unincorporated association) may not have direct or indirect interest in more than one license issued by the Board. The identity, address and percentage of ownership of any person, having 5% or more of direct or indirect ownership interest in the business conducted on the licensed premises shall be disclosed to the Board in writing.
